### TONIGHT'S THE NIGHT!

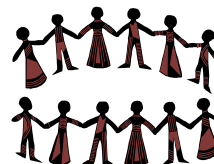

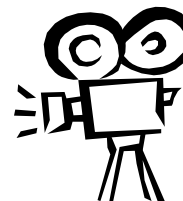
