IMPORTANT CHECK-OUT INFORMATION

Sadly the time has come to leave SUUSI 2007. We hope you had a fabulous week!

Checking Out

1. Please return your dorm furniture to its original location.
2. Return your keys to the 1st floor of Payne Saturday between 7 and 11 am. (If you need to leave before Saturday 7 am, see note below**.)
3. Please fill out the key return envelope that you received in your arrival packet (if you don't have an envelope, extras are available at key drop off).
4. Indicate on the envelope how you want us to handle your key deposit check. Please donate to SUUSIships if you can, or indicate that it should be voided. (Upon verification of the keys being returned, your check or credit card info will be destroyed). We will notify you if your key is missing.
5. **DO NOT** bring your car around until you have moved all of your luggage to one of the move-out locations and you have returned your keys. This **MUST** be done before you go get your car. (If cars are parked in the Owens parking lot on Friday night, they will be ticketed.)

** If you have to leave before Saturday morning at 7 am, please leave your keys (in your key return envelope) with the staff at the VT 24-hour desk in P-Y. Be sure to complete the information on the envelope. Can't find your envelope?! Don't worry, the P-Y desk and the SUUSI Info Office will have extras.

Loading Your Car

We'll all be moving out (all 970+ people) about the same time on Saturday, so it will be important to follow the procedure described below, and to share the parking spaces available during move-out.

1. Return your keys first! See section above.
2. **BEFORE** you retrieve your car, move your luggage to one of the loading areas behind Owens or between Lee and Pritchard. (Cars left in these areas could be ticketed or moved because these parking lots are reserved **only** for loading). Leave a family member with your stuff, or ask one of the Move-Out volunteers to watch it for you.
3. Walk or take one of the shuttle vans to the parking lot to retrieve your car. One shuttle will run from 8-9 am and two will run from after Closing Circle until noon. Vans will shuttle to Litton-Reaves parking from both loading areas.

4. Van space is limited, so if you have an opportunity to give someone a ride to the parking lot, please do so as one last SUUSI kindness.

5. Do not drive on the sidewalk.

We hope to have volunteers at both loading sites. We also encourage you to organize with your suite mates and dorm neighbors to stay with the luggage while the drivers go pick up the cars. People who loaned dollies and hand-trucks for move in, THANK YOU. If you can, please share those again on Saturday morning.

Please follow the move-out procedures above to help participants get home safely as soon as possible. Following these procedures will help prevent gridlock in loading areas that happened during move-in! We thank you for your cooperation in advance.

Linens

If you borrowed linens from VT, you are responsible for returning them to the P-Y 24-hour desk. As a reminder, your bag included two sheets, one pillowcase, two towels and one washcloth.

Take Out the Trash and Recycling

We are responsible for removal of all trash and recyclable materials from the dorm buildings. Please take all trash and recyclables to one of the dumpsters behind Pritchard, O'Shag/Owens, Slusher or Payne. If you leave trash in your rooms, SUUSI will be billed for the removal. Please help keep SUUSI's expenses as low as possible.

Please help us remove any SUUSI-related signs you see around campus. A small effort by each of us can make a big difference to the SUUSI budget.
